**P**hilip Uri Treisman is professor of mathematics and executive director of the Charles A. Dana Center for Mathematics and Science Education at the University of Texas at Austin. Treisman is a leading expert on the development of programs aimed at increasing minority participation in mathematics. His seminal research in this area provided a foundation for his Emerging Scholars Programs (ESP). Now a workshop model used by colleges and universities nationwide, ESP builds student success through collaborative group work on rigorous mathematical problems.

**F**or his work on fostering minority and student achievement in mathematics, Treisman was named a MacArthur Fellow in 1992, and one of the outstanding leaders of higher education in the 20<sup>th</sup> century by the magazine *Black Issues in Higher Education* in 1999. In 2006, he was named "Scientist of the Year" by the Harvard Foundation of Harvard University. In all his work, he is an advocate for equity and excellence in education for all children.
