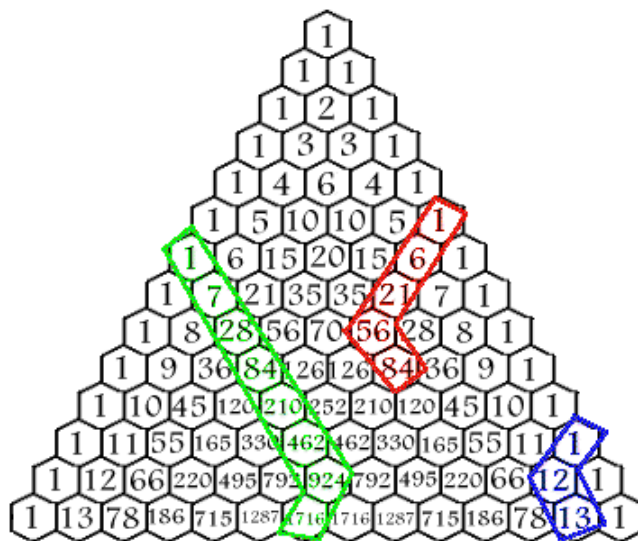
PROBLEMS IN NUMBER THEORY AND COMBINATORICS
